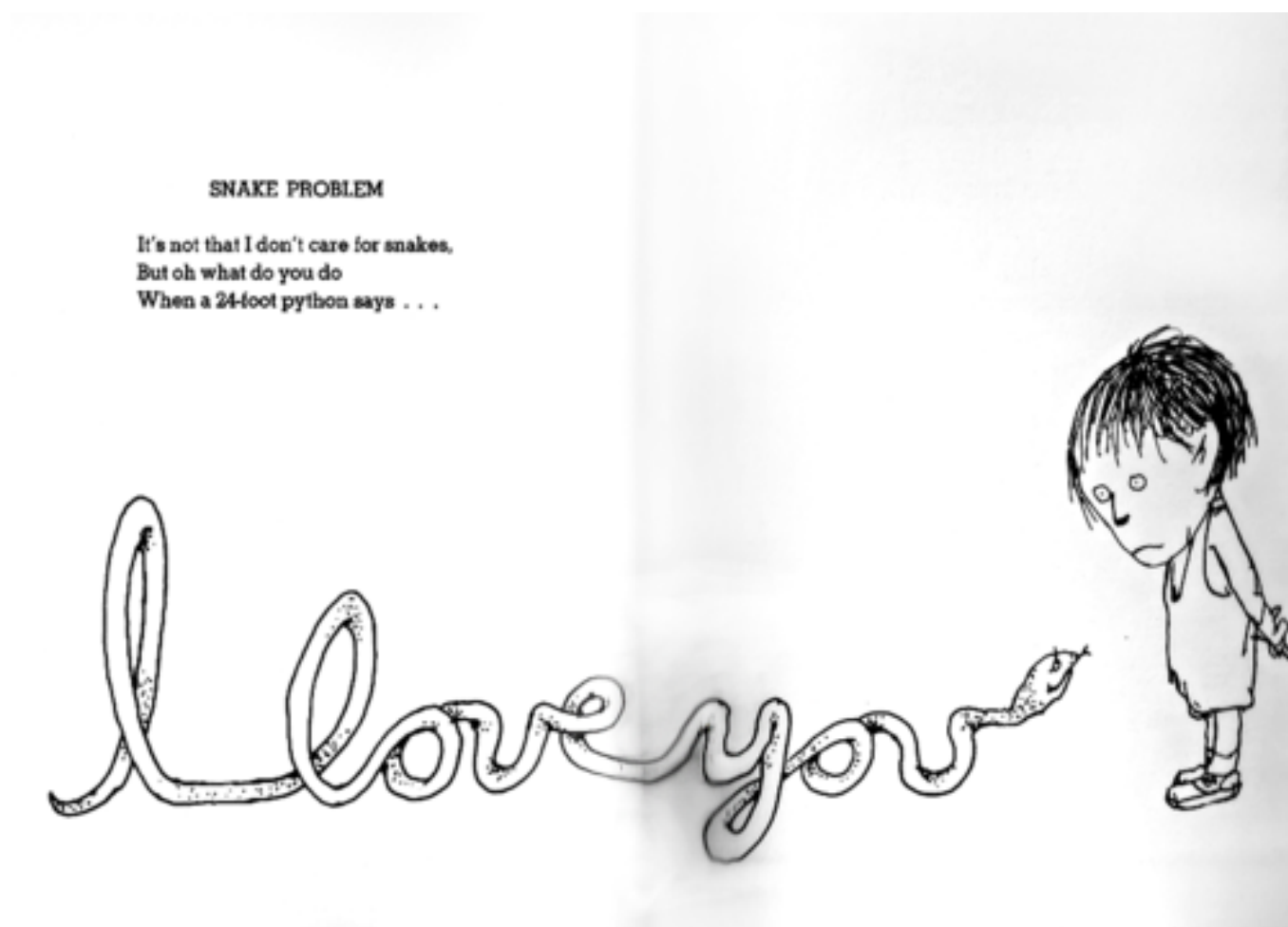


# Third Grade-In Person-Sneaky Snake

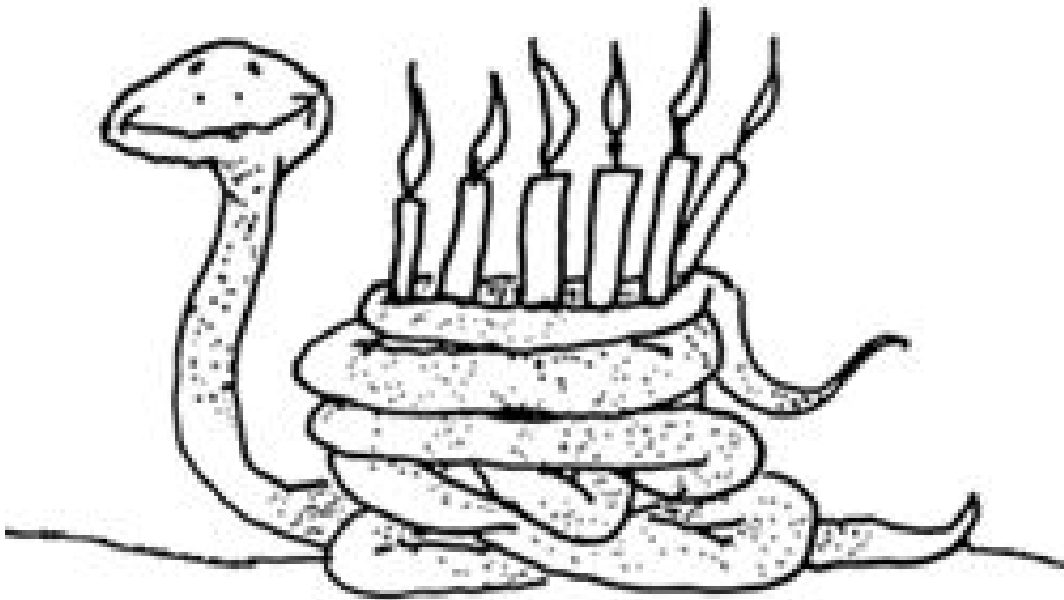
Lets begin with the end in mind... Below are some images of finished Sneaky Snake Sculptures!



Here is a funny poem about a snake called Birthday by Shel Silverstein!

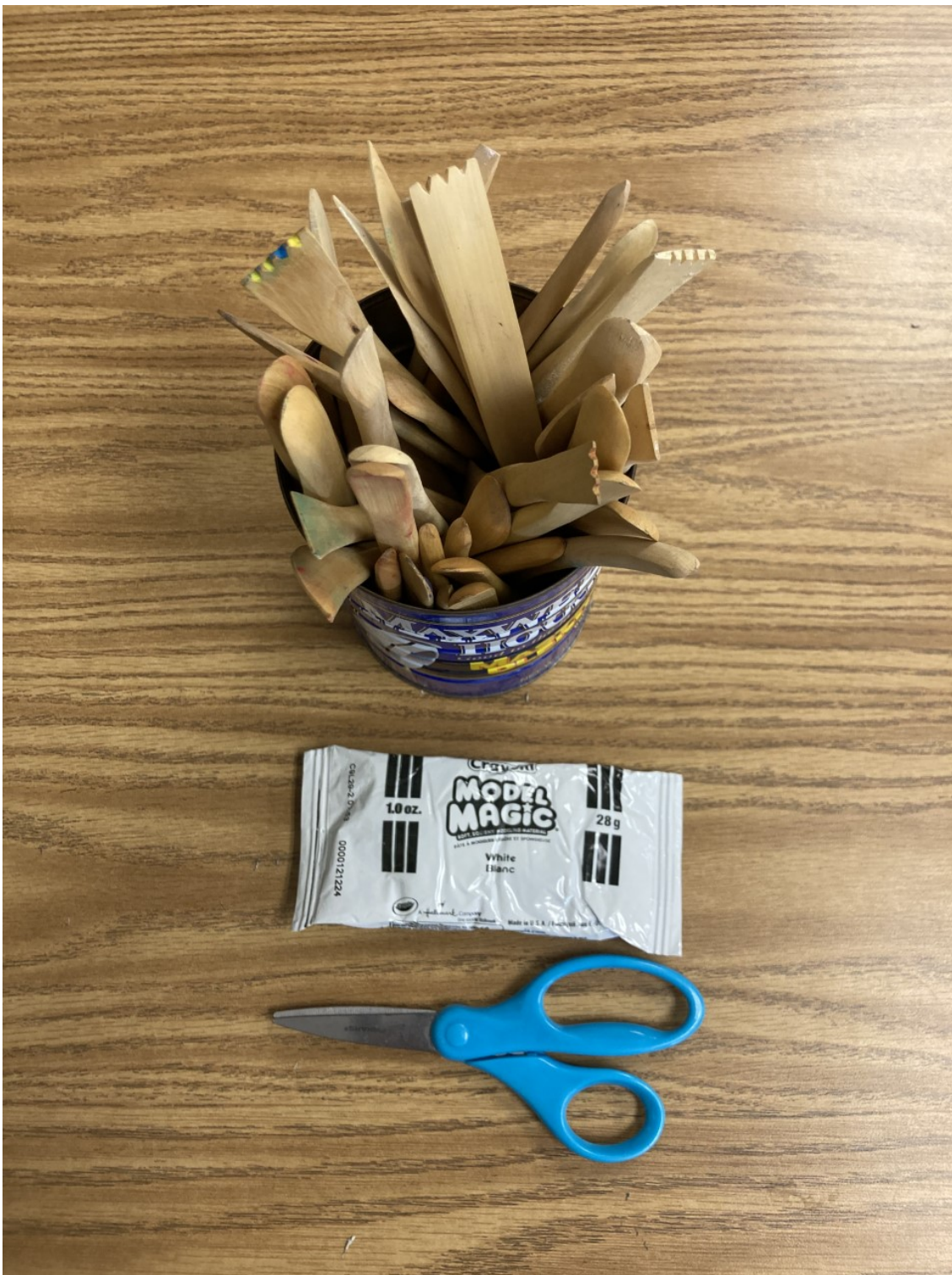
## BIRTHDAY

Materials: Model Magic, Modeling tools, Scissors

(eventually you may also want some markers or paints to color your snake)



Watch the instructional video below to see how to make your sneaky snake!

1. Open the package
2. Pull out the Model Magic and throw away the wrapper.
3. Squeeze the Model Magic out into a hot dog shape.
4. Use the palms of your hands to roll the Model Magic across the surface of your table to make a coil (A long thin body for your snake!)
5. Use the modeling tools at your table to create patterns and textures on your snake.  
Press the ends of the tools into the Model Magic to make patterns and create textures!  
Repeat shapes and lines to create patterns in the Model Magic!
6. Use the tools to add the head and tail details to your snake... fangs, tongue or rattle or cheeks!
7. Position your snake to dry!
8. After 48 hours (two days) of hardening, you can add marker or paint to color your snake!
